3. Qualifications

Celebrating our individual differences that make us proud to be part of one Keystone Oaks Community

- Must be original work of the applicant
- Must attend Keystone Oaks School District

4. Format

- Entry must be titled
- Securely attach or enclose the entry form
- Student's name and school should be clearly printed on the entry form.

5. Winning Applicants

- Notification of awards will be sent to the winning student's school and home
- The winners will be recognized by the Superintendent and School Board on April 10, 2018.

6. Return of Entries

- Entries will be returned to the students

7. Judging Criteria

- Originality
- Creativity
- Support of the theme
- Artistic endeavor
