STUDENT RECOGNITION

The Board recognized two groups of students at the beginning of the meeting:

BOARD PRESIDENT'S REPORT

The Board voted to appoint Mr. Matt Cesario to the Office of Treasurer to serve for a one-year term beginning July 1, 2015.

The Board voted to approve the Special Voting Minutes of April 9, 2015, Work Session Minutes of April 21, 2015 and the Business/Legislative Minutes of April 30, 2015. The minutes will be posted on the District's website for review.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

The Board voted to approve the renewed contract for Christopher Swickline, Director of Buildings, Grounds & Transportation, for a term effective July 1, 2015 through June 30, 2017.

FACILITIES REPORT

The Board voted to approve North Star Communications, Inc. for the installation of cameras at Aiken, Dormont and Myrtle Avenue Elementary Schools at an amount not to exceed \$25,000.

The Board voted to approve the contract with NaviGate Prepared for the purchase of a school safety response data system at a cost of \$8,200 for the 2015-2016 school year.

The Board voted to approve AT&T to upgrade its antennas on the Keystone Oaks Middle School roof as per the Consent Letter. Additional RF testing will follow after installation.

The Board voted to approve water-based traffic markings for the newly paved surfaces on all District property.
