- 2. Coaches Year End Meetings:** Winter coaches will meet individually with me at the end of the month to review the season and set goals for the 15/16 season
- 3. Winter Sports:** **Ben Morton** qualified for WPIAL Diving, **Joey Kazalas** placed 2nd in the Allegheny County Wrestling tournament, Wrestling came in 2nd place in the Section and Competed in the WPIAL Team Wrestling Tournament. **Mike Lydon** qualified for WPIAL swimming in the 500 Free style.
- 4. Middle School Girls Soccer:** The program will start back up for the 2015/2016 season. Numbers are in the 20's.
