## 1) HS Boiler

- a. Schneider
  - i. Investigation work complete
  - ii. Selection of condensing boiler not driven by cost savings, but by systems design.
  - iii. Chris has questions on condensing boiler life, construction materials
  - iv. Need to run a flue up the back of the building stainless steel pipe Chris has some concerns. What about drilling? How to get it out of boiler room?
  - v. What is drop dead date? (Schneider provided a post meeting email stating that with a June 21<sup>st</sup> approval, full system completion would be in mid-November)
- b. Smith / Arc Ultra for HS boiler
  - i. Apples to apples with Schneider work
  - ii. Comparable with lower scope Schneider option
  - iii. COSTARS
  - iv. Can have it ready for a June vote
  - v. Committee recommends running in parallel for June decision
- 2) Dormont Boiler Hot Water Tank
  - a. Short cycling, tank rusting out, beginning to leak
  - b. ~ \$100 K
  - c. Will do several quote, do COSTARS (Tobey Karg, Huck, Combustion)
  - d. Want for this summer, prep for June
- 3) Construction Update
  - a. Ongoing Schneider update
    - i. What is status of finances of ongoing work?
    - ii. Physical work "Very near" completions
    - iii. MS at punchlist. 1 week of FT commissioning. Then misc.
    - iv. Elementaries are "much much" better off even with shake out work
  - b. Lighting started at Dormont
    - i. Need to vote on additional scope, will be less than \$30 K
    - ii. Phase 2 is HS, want to pull forward exterior lights from this phase to get it all done

- iii. Under canopy, elementary control additions
- iv. For lower wall packs, extra cost for fixture might be offset by labor look into
- v. Will do interior and exterior of each building before moving on
