Purpose</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">POLICY NO. 263 PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT AT DANCES/SOCIALS</p> <p>The purpose of this policy is to promote parental involvement as chaperones dances/socials at the middle school and high school.</p> <p>The sponsor of a club or class who desires to hold a dance or social in the middle school or high school should keep parents informed and arrange for parents to play a role as chaperones at the event.</p> <p>Planning for the prom and after-prom will include an advisory group of representative senior parents with input from the high school Senior High Organization of Parents (SHOP). Parents will be invited to serve as chaperones. The sponsor of any dance/social will provide the chaperones with a list of responsibilities and expectations, as well as a copy of the school's discipline policy.</p> <p>The director of activities will publicize this policy to all club, activity, and class sponsors and the student body via the student councils.</p> <p>The superintendent will take appropriate administrative steps to implement and publicize this policy to sponsors, students, and parents.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">Page 1 of 1</p>	
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
