256 – Anti Bullying

- Not due for renewal until Dec. 2018.
- Need to ensure that our handbooks have the most up to date versions of this policy.
- Need further clarification on proposed changes before updating.

808 – Food Services

- This is an update from PSBA to bring all districts in compliance to new “no food shaming” regulations. It was always the policy of Keystone Oaks to provide a meal regardless of whether a student could pay or not.
- Do we still need an 808.2 policy (Free/Reduced-Price Meals and Free Milk)? Might have been removed by PSBA or included in updated 808 from PSBA.
- Need a better feedback loop between parents/guardians and District food services. Students may be being encouraged to purchase “extras” despite parent/guardian direction to the contrary.
- While we cannot deny a meal to a student, per law, we can restrict them from certain activities (extracurriculars, graduation, etc.) if there is an outstanding balance. Add wording to support this.
- Section regarding “bad debt” is more internal accounting related. Do not include.

808.1 – Food Services Student Accounts

- All the relevant info from this policy is now contained in updated 808. Can remove 808.1.

123.1 – Concussion Management

- It is important that information regarding concussions and risks needs to be made more available to students and parents.
- Added information regarding accommodations that can be made for students who may have symptoms of a traumatic brain injury.
- Remove wording in the proposed form that lists specific sports. All activities carry risk.

123.2 – Sudden Cardiac Arrest

- This form is provided from PDE.
- Language in this policy should be very similar to language in 123.1.
