## **823 – Tobacco Free Environment**

- This policy needed an update to make sure that electronic and vaping products were also prohibited on school grounds. Other tobacco products were already prohibited.
- Changing name to “Use of Tobacco and Vapor Products”. This applies to students, employees, and visitors.
- Current wording would ban smoking cessation products such as nicotine gum and patches. Committee discussed modifying this to allow these products if used for purposes of smoking cessation.
- Noted that increased signage (i.e. “No smoking”) around campuses is needed.
- Ready for first reading.

## **204 – Attendance**

- Committee discussed again that internal procedures need to be consistent K-12 and across buildings. These are currently being updated.
- Ready for first reading.

## 247 – Hazing

- Students may report incidents of hazing to any employee. Staff members will then report any such incidents to their immediate supervisor.
- Individuals knowledgeable of a hazing incident that don't report it may also be subject to criminal prosecution under PA law. Modified wording: "Any person who causes or participates in hazing and/or is knowledgeable of a hazing event and fails to report may also be subject to criminal prosecution."
