Contest Rules

Eligibility

- Open to all students in Grades K-12 in the Keystone Oaks School District
- One entry per student in each category

Deadline

- Entries must be submitted by Friday, March 6, 2020.

Qualifications

- The entry must address the theme -

"I like you just the way you are."

Mr. Rogers said it best: Everyone has qualities that make them unique and special. What are the characteristics that define who you are? How do you embrace and celebrate your individuality, as well as the diversity of every member of the Keystone Oaks community, to help build a welcoming, inclusive school environment?

- Must be original work of the applicant
- Must attend Keystone Oaks School District

Format

- Entry must be titled
- Securely attach or enclose the entry form
- Student's name and school should be clearly printed on the entry form.

Winning Applicants

- Notification of awards will be sent to the winning student's school and home
- The winners will be recognized by the Superintendent and School Board on April 14, 2020.

Judging Criteria

- Originality
- Support of the theme
- Creativity
- Artistic endeavor

Prizes

All applicants will receive a certificate of participation from the Keystone Oaks School District. One winner from each grade cluster will be selected in each category. Each student will be presented with a small gift and a \$25 gift card. Winning entries will be on display in Central Administration.
