A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SCHOOL DIRECTORS OF THE KEYSTONE OAKS SCHOOL DISTRICT, ALLEGHENY COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO IMPLEMENT ACT 57 OF 2022 WHICH DIRECTS TAX COLLECTORS TO WAIVE ADDITONAL CHARGES FOR REAL ESTAT TAXES IN CERTAIN SITUATIONS

WHEREAS, Act 57 of 2022, amending the Local Tax Collection Law, was signed by

Governor Wolf on July 11, 2022, and took effect on October 10, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Act 57 requires taxing districts that impose taxes on the assessed value of

real property to adopt a resolution or ordinance directing the tax collector to waive

additional charges for real estate taxes in certain situations; and

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Board of School Directors of the Keystone

Oaks School District, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same:

1. The following words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them within this

resolution unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:

"Additional charge": Any interest, fee, penalty, or charge accruing to and in excess of the

face amount of the real estate tax as provided in the real estate tax notice.

"Qualifying event":

a. For the purposes of real property, the date of transfer of ownership. b. For manufactured or mobile homes, the date of transfer of ownership or the date a lease agreement commences for the original location or relocation of a manufactured or mobile home on a parcel of land not owned by the owner of the manufactured or mobile home. The term does not include the renewal of a lease for the same location.

"Tax Collector": The tax collectors for the Keystone Oaks School District, Borough of Castle Shannon, Borough of Dormont Borough and Borough of Green Tree, any authorized or designated delinquent tax collector, an employee, agent or assignee authorized to collect the tax, a purchaser of claim for the tax or any other person authorized by law or contract to secure collection of, or take any action at law or in equity against the person or property of the taxpayer for the real estate tax or amounts, liens or claims derived from the real estate tax.

2. The Tax Collector shall, for tax years beginning on and after January 1, 2023, grant a request to waive additional charges for real estate taxes if the taxpayer does all of the following:

a. Provides a waiver request of additional charges, on a form provided by the state Department of Community and Economic Development, to the Tax Collector in possession of the claim within twelve (12) months of a Qualifying Event;

b. Attests that a tax notice was not received; and

c. Provides the Tax Collector in possession of the claim with one of the following:
